



PROOF OF IDENTITY

As part of your engagement, we require you to provide the following certified* proof of identity **and** physical residential address:

A. Proof of Identity

Option 1: Certified* photocopy of:

Appropriate pages of New Zealand or overseas passport, containing your name, date of birth, photograph and signature
New Zealand firearms licence
New Zealand certificate of identity
Overseas government-issued national identity card, containing your name, date of birth, photograph and signature

Option 2: Certified* photocopy of

accompanied by a Certified* photocopy of:

New Zealand Drivers Licence	Credit card issued by a New Zealand registered bank
	Bank account statement issued by a New Zealand registered bank in the last one calendar year
	Statement issued by the Inland Revenue Department in the last one calendar year
	SuperGold card
	Community services card
	New Zealand government issued identification

Option 3 Certified* photocopy of

accompanied by a Certified* photocopy of:

18+ card	New Zealand or overseas full birth certificate
New Zealand Government issued identification	New Zealand or overseas citizenship certificate

B. Proof of Physical Residential Address

Certified* photocopy of 1 of the following documents issued within the last 3 months

Utility bill	Car registration document
Bank account statement	Insurance policy document
Statement issued by the IRD	Hire purchase statement
Rates bill	Rental tenancy agreement

*Certification: Copies of identification can be certified as true copies with an original signature by a New Zealand police constable, New Zealand Lawyer, New Zealand or overseas Notary Public, New Zealand or overseas Justice of Peace. The full name and occupation of the certifier and the date of certification must be clearly noted. The certifier must sight the original identification, and make a statement to the effect that the documents provided are true copies and represent the identity of the named individual.

**Certification services are provided for a fee of NZD 30.00 if the certification is a separate, non-associated matter with a current engagement.
